The AEYC Juneau Parents as Teachers (PAT) is a voluntary home visiting program for any family that is pregnant or with a child up to age 3 and can serve a family for up to 3 years. PAT is designed to support families, increase parent knowledge of early childhood development, and improve parenting practices.

## What Does Parents As Teachers Do?

**Personal Home Visits:** Certified Parent Educators make regular visits to the homes of participating families every two to four weeks. During these visits, educators provide timely information on child development. Information is shared through developmentally appropriate materials, and honest and frank conversations between parents and Parent Educators.

**Screenings:** All enrolled children receive a free vision, hearing, and developmental screening so that potential problems can be identified and addressed as early as possible.

**Resource Networks:** Families are connected to resources in the community, for all levels of need.
