What are My Responsibilities?

- 1. Be a legal resident of Southeast Alaska.
- Submit an official registration form, completely filled out by parent or guardian. (Form must be approved and on file with the Southeast Alaska Imagination Library.)
- 3. Notify the Southeast Alaska Imagination Library anytime your address changes. Books are mailed to the address listed on the official registration form. If the child's address changes, you must contact your friends at the address shown below in order to continue receiving books.
- 4. Read with your child.

When Will My Child Receive Books?

For children who register before the 9th day of the month, books will begin arriving at your home at the end of the following month and will continue until your child turns five or you move out of the service area.
